Equipping women to connect to God and one another

"You want us to what?!" No one said this out loud, but I read it all over the faces of the thirty-six women gathered at the Longmont Church of Christ one Wednesday night in early September. I had been invited to kick off the Human AND Holy series for their ladies' class.

At the end of the class, I invited the women to open up with the same two or three women with whom they had already shared their answers to some earlier questions. The topic was the Common Threads – a way to make any lesson personal and practical, listed below as they appear at the end of each of the chapters in *Human AND Holy*.

The initial silence was uncomfortable for many, but as soon as one or two ladies

began to speak in their groups, the noise level and everyone's body language communicated a hunger for connecting more deeply with one another in this way. Women realized that they are not alone – not the only one struggling to grow in the same ways or fighting the same battles.

Confession is good for the soul, but hard on the pride. It is not a practice we are comfortable with. However, when we allow God to do His healing work, confession

brings about freedom and transformation – through it, we are able to deepen our relationships with God and one another.

In a world of ____, we long for the sincerity and authenticity found in Christian

friendship. One of Iron Rose Sister Ministries' primary purposes is to facilitate opportunities like the one realized at the Longmont Church of Christ that night – equipping women to connect to God and one another more deeply.
