We trust in the name of the Lord our God!

Psalm 20 ends with "Lord, give victory to the king. Answer us when we call." Therefore, the last class at the Eastside Church of Christ Ladies' Retreat at the Glen Eyrie castle in Colorado Springs, CO, focused on the difference between personal victory and a victory for the King of Kings – in other words, we don't always get what we want, but we are on the winning team!

As part of that winning team, we can call and cry out in celebration (Psalm 20:5, 9), not just in distress (Psalm 20:1).

To close the retreat, we read **Psalm 20** to one another, **spoken as a prayer** over each of our Christian sisters present. We looked into each other's eyes as we read verses like, "May the Lord grant all your requests." And "Now this I



know: The Lord gives victory to his anointed."

But **the most powerful moment for me** was when we got to verse 7. "Some trust in chariots and some in horses..." The volume rose and the certainty swelled as each lady finished the verse as one voice "BUT WE TRUST IN THE NAME OF THE LORD OUR GOD." They owned it. They believe it. And they were strengthened to remember it as we carried on beyond the weekend events. I had chills and my eyes filled with tears, humbled by the simple and heartfelt proclamation by these women.

One of the ladies came up to me after the event ended on Saturday, looking around to make sure no one was within earshot as she began to express her thanks. "The topic for the classes you taught was perfect for me. No one really knows this, but I suffer from depression and some of the things you shared really helped me. I remembered that I am not alone. I have my Christian sisters surrounding me and God is fighting for me. Thank you."

The men and women of the **Rural Hill Church of Christ** in Nashville, TN, excelled in their first-ever Ladies' Day for Hispanic women.


What an honor to **co-labor with** these humble servants in the

Sixty-four times in the Old and New Testament (in the NIV), there is a reference to God's right hand. Over two years ago, one of those passages came to life for me and, since that time, the references have jumped off the pages of my Bible. God's right hand has comforted me, strengthened me, and guided me. God's right hand has upheld me and IRSM in ways through which he gets all the glory.

When I don't know where to turn or feel worries that threaten to overwhelm me, I remind myself that God's got this—and I place myself back in his right hand.

Thankfully, these promises are not for me alone. I pray that others will come to own them through a six-week interactive Bible study that I have written for women. This new book: *In God's Right Hand: Whom Shall I Fear*? will be available this fall!

Securely upheld in God's right hand, whom shall I fear? As a vivid description of our Heavenly Father that transcends the Old and New Testament, God's right hand is a special place of honor from which he demonstrates power and authority, promises protection and salvation, and provides a source of strength. Through this six-week interactive Bible study, we will explore these characteristics of God's living and active right hand in our lives. Let's join hands with him and walk together on the journey!

Whether your mother by birth, an adoptive mom, foster mom, or a spiritual mother that you want to recognize, here are a few ideas:


