## Portuguese Expansion Opens Doors in Angola, Central Africa


As a ministry, we always knew that Portuguese would be our third language (with an emphasis across the Americas). What we didn't know was that Africa would be our third continent!

Angola and Mozambique are two African countries that list Portuguese as their official language. We have shared stories like how Marlene prayed to God to teach her to listen, and our book, Chamada a Escutar (Called to Listen) arrived at her door in her own language! Thanks again to Jordan Yarbrough who prayed for God to lead her to someone who needed that book and followed the Lord's guidance!

Iron Rose Sister Ministries has been offered a special opportunity to partner with the Churches of Christ in Angola, LAMP International (Luso-Africa Mission Partners), and Global Share Missions.

The Gathering will take place in Luanda, Angola, June 1-5. IRSM will equip women who attend through a series of 12 classes. Other resources will be provided and more copes of *Chamada a Escutar* will be distributed.

Our new Brazil Coordinator, Beliza Da Silva, will travel from Brazil to teach and will partner with Jordan who is living and serving as a mis-



sionary in Angola. Join us in thanking God for this unique opened door and for His provision to answer this call.

# A Note from Michelle: Trilingual Prayer Gathering and 10th Annual Prayer Month

#### "It's definitely Prayer Month!"

For the past 10 years, every February, I have repeated that phrase. Some years more than others, my expression is an affirmation of the spiritual battle that intensifies, coupled by the overwhelming, yet humbling demonstrations of God's faithfulness.

Prayer Month started a little early this year as late January greeted us with personal trials amongst the team.

My grandmother was critically ill in the

hospital, next door to another team member's father. Another team member's house flooded and frankly, I don't want to remember the ways in which our prayer list expanded weekly on behalf of many who were struggling.

However, the first

weekend in February, during our first Trilingual Prayer Event, our "light and momentary troubles" paled in comparison to the glory that God received through His daughters. We prayed, worshipped, and read Scripture in three languages!!! Women from more than a dozen countries across four continents met virtually! What. A. Blessing.

Any time a Team member felt her faith waver or discouragement creep in, we would remind one another. "It's definitely Prayer Month." It helped refocus our vision and trust God's faithfulness in the trials.

And, oh my friends, He. Is. Faithful. In His timing and in His ways... just look at the countless answered prayers in this newsletter! Before February came to a close, after finally ceasing my own efforts to identify a Brazil Coordinator, God led us to Beliza. And did you notice that repeated prayers for a Creative Director were answered the same week?! All in God's perfect timing and way, even serving as an in-person illustration during the bilingual event in Houston!

Special thanks to every single one of you who pray for us and with us. Every year when we gather as one voice to petition and thank God in specific ways, we proclaim, "It's definitely Prayer Month!"
