Mini-Equipping Workshops

To multiply the impact of the Ambassadors Equipping Workshop, 'Bear Fruit,' we are conducting Mini-Equipping Workshops: 'Bearing Fruit in God's Kingdom.' These customizable workshops encourage women to facilitate intentional and fruitful teaching and small groups. Bentonville Church of Christ in Arkansas hosted the first with women from four local congregations. At the Singing Oaks Church of Christ in Denton, TX, women heard inspiring stories from other women bearing fruit across the Americas. The Goodman Oaks Church of Christ in Southaven, MS, will host the first bilingual Mini-Equipping Workshop in October!

## Four Cities in Argentina and Ecuador

The **Iglesia de Cristo Redentor** (Redeemer Church of Christ) in **Buenos Aires, Argentina**, did an excellent job coordinating and preparing for the area-wide Ladies' Day Saturday, April 25. The men cooked and a committee of women prepared and served in big and small ways—all important and appreciated, as in the body of Christ.

Celebrated through the theme, **“Connected in Christ”** (1Co 12:12), 80 women from five congregations joined for the lessons and small group discussions.

Even eight years after the initial visit to **Ecuador**, the impact of IRSM and a hunger for our biblical resources was evident.

The **Central Cuenca** congregation hosted a two-day area-wide event over a holiday weekend with 68 women. New women's ministry leaders shadowed those who have

served in those roles in the past.

In **Quito**, we met with the sisters from La Colón congregation and received an invitation for the national women's conference in 2027.

And in **Tabacundo**, the women did not want the area-wide Ladies' Day to end. The teaching, small group discussions, and application activity focused on how God invites us to live **“Unveiled and Unashamed”** before Him and one another (Ro 1:16-17; 2Co 3-4).
