

IRSM Speaker Ambassador Rubric

The rubric below will be used to assess an IRSM Speaker Ambassador and provide feedback. Assessments will be done by a Mentoring Speaker Ambassador, IRSM Board member, or designated staff member. A formal assessment will be completed after a Speaker Ambassador's first speaking engagement. Continued assessment will be at the discretion of the Ambassadors Program Committee.

1. *Biblical accuracy, relevancy, and foundation
2. *Personal and practical nature of the lesson and applications
3. Inclusion of A SISTER [borrowed from Dr. George Brown with permission]
 - a. Analogies (figurative and literal)
 - b. Statistics (rounded, personalized, or interactive)
 - c. Illustrations (story, hypothetical, and actual)
 - d. Specific Examples (name that person, place, or thing to show practicality)
 - e. Testimonies (literary, expert, ordinary, or personal)
 - f. Explanations (how, what, why)
 - g. Reiterations (repetition or paraphrase)
4. Interactive elements (call and response, "turn to your neighbor," question/answer, others read Bible verses, etc.)
5. Visual aids (PowerPoint, marker board, demonstrations, show-and-tell, etc.)
6. Incorporated the use of the Common Threads
7. Follow-up questions (ideally prepared for a small group context)
8. Homework or "Where do we go from here" instructions

* Indicates an element that must be included

The expectation is that the speaker will utilize a variety of methods and strategies in order to reach a diverse audience with multiple learning styles. The use of non-required elements will depend on the nature of the class (virtual, in-person, size of audience, time allotted, etc.).

Speakers will be evaluated on the effective presentation of points 1 and 2.

Speakers will be evaluated on the inclusion of at least two of the elements in point 3.

Speakers will be evaluated on the utilization of at least two elements from points 4-8.

The following range of growth potential will be used to provide feedback for the included elements:

Utilized effectively

Underutilized

Utilized ineffectively

Absent
