"Refined and Redefined": Ladies' Seminar in Zipaquirá

On Saturday, July 27th, thirty sisters from Chía, San Gil, Funza, Zipaquirá, and Bogotá attended the "Refined and Redefined" ladies' seminar, organized by the **Zipaquirá congregation in Colombia**. The turnout was perfect for the space available.

I am personally satisfied with the outcome, as I believe the message was well received. The participants engaged in two classes: "Identity Redefined (2Cor 3:17-18)" and "Refined through Relationships (Pr 27:17)." We emphasized that only God defines our identity and that we need to submit to the transformation process He initiates in us, both personally and through our relationships with others. The sisters thoroughly enjoyed the small group interactions. We organized six groups and many requested more time to share and interact. I believe many left

with the contact information of a new sister and friend.


Beliza Across Brazil: Teaching and Representing MIRF

It wasn't long ago that we launched the branch of the ministry in Brazil. Throughout 2024, we are having the opportunity to **deepen the bonds** we have built through visits, classes, and participation in events.

Our **Brazil Coordinator, Beliza Kočev,** had the opportunity to present the ministry in new places. She even received an invitation from a sister (who learned about the ministry a year ago) to present the ministry at an event for the congregations in Paraíba. During her visit to Rio Grande do Sul, participating in ENFESUL, Beliza met sisters who had watched a class taught by **Michelle J. Goff in South Florida** broadcast simultaneously **to Brazil** via Zoom. During the time in ENFESUL, sisters who were interested in the ministry **invited Beliza to participate in other women's events, in other states, to introduce the ministry to more women.**

Brazil is a big country of diverse people and we are excited to equip and empower women from north to south.

Thankfully, God had gone before me and provided **three women here in the Searcy office** and other team members across the world who were already doing their parts in support. Since Beliza, our Brazil Coordinator, also lost her voice at the same time, there was a lot of empathy to go around!
