The physical copies she uses are from our BOGO program (Buy One, Gift One). When someone purchases a book, she has the option to donate half again the cost of another book allowing us to donate these resources to others in Central or South America. These women have done what they could.

A Note from Michelle: How Do We Stay True?

I was recently asked how a nonprofit can remain true to its vision and primary purpose, especially when experiencing exponential growth or bringing on new workers to the team. I thought it fitting to share part of my answer here.

- 1. Prayer. It is God who guides our steps (Pr 16:3,9).
- 2. Trust. Only God can keep us



walking in His ways (Pr 3:5-6).

- Focus. If we each keep our eyes fixed on Jesus and the purpose He has set before us, we will walk together along that path toward our goal (Heb 12:2).
- 4. Iron sharpening iron. We all get off track at times. We get distracted or discouraged. When we have someone else to hold us accountable and remind us of Truth, we can stay sharp and continue serving (Pr 27:17).
- 5. Communication. "...speaking to one another in psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs... do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths... building others
